

Openings for New Members at Robbins Farm Garden

Robbins Farm Garden is a cooperative community garden project at Robbins Farm Park in Arlington, MA. Since 2010, we've grown vegetables organically as a group, created an educational resource in the community and continued the agricultural tradition of the farm at the park. We garden Saturday mornings April – November with an additional mid-week harvest session June – September. The project is run through Arlington's Recreation Department.



- No experience necessary – learn from fellow gardeners
- Single large plot gardened cooperatively by all the gardeners (no individual plots)
- Grow a wide variety of vegetables and herbs (over 140 varieties last season!)
- Socialize with other gardeners and visitors to this educational garden
- Share the work load and harvest at each gardening session
- Take your summer vacation knowing that the garden will be well cared for!

All gardening at Robbins Farm Garden is done in group sessions. Interested Arlington residents are encouraged to drop in on a Saturday morning (9a-12p) session in the spring to garden with us before deciding to join; new members may join through May, 2019.

Membership information:

- Open to Arlington residents. Children may participate with parental permission
- Fee of \$85 per year (\$60 used toward garden supplies, \$25 to the Town for use of public space)
- Members expected to make an earnest commitment to contribute to group efforts over the gardening season
