The mission of the garden is to create a high-engagement learning resource for visitors to Robbins Farm Park, local schools and the public, while affording gardeners an opportunity to plant, cultivate, and harvest vegetables, herbs and flowers for their beauty and utility. The garden provides learning opportunities through active participation with experienced member gardeners, tours of the garden for the public, a web site directed toward grade-school kids, and an on-line journal directed towards adults and experienced gardeners (robbinsfarmgarden.org). The garden is single large plot gardened cooperatively by all the gardeners. There are no individual plots.

Each gardener is expected to make an earnest commitment to contribute to group efforts over the gardening season in some mix of the activities described above, including preparation, planting, harvesting, watering, cleaning up, giving tours, and contributing to the web site.

Each gardener pays a \$25 fee to the Town of Arlington for the use of the public space, and an additional fee to the garden account (\$60 in 2023) to cover the shared costs of operating the garden, such as seeds, seedlings, soil amendments and other supplies, as agreed among the gardeners. The harvest is shared among the gardeners and visitors. Robbins Farm Garden uses sustainable, organic practices.

Photographs are routinely taken for educational purposes as we document the gardening season. Photos are occasionally used in promotional media for the garden such as flyers or social media.
